

5. AURIOL BOWLING CLUB **Social Membership Rules**

1. Social Membership is available to anyone who wishes to be a non-playing member of the Club. Outlined below are the benefits of the current Social Membership Annual Fee: -
 - a) Have complete access to Club premises during the season in order to follow individual and team competitions and keep up with Club news; be able to watch any home or away matches and attend Finals Day.
 - b) Attend Club Social events at no further cost, such as the Mixed Ploughman's, Fish and Chip Supper, Finals Day Buffet.
 - c) Attend and vote at the Pre-season and Annual General Meetings.
 - d) Social Members are allowed to participate in:
 - i) The two Captains versus Vice-Captains Matches;
 - ii) All Club Drives throughout the year;
 - iii) All Social matches throughout the year;
(but would have to pay the relevant green fee – currently £2 - on each occasion).
 - iv) Social Members are also entitled to play a maximum of FOUR times per season outside of the above, i.e. in roll-ups only (the member to record each session in the hut diary).
 - e) If any Social Member wishes to play in excess of the above, eg. in matches or competitions within the Club, they would be expected to pay the relevant annual subscription fee as paid by Full Members.
 - f) Any Social Member can 'hire a rink', for which they would have to pay the fee per person set by Epsom & Ewell Borough Council. This would NOT entitle entry into any part of Club activity.
